Q: How do I find out more information on the ROKiT Homes Announcement?

Q: What are the qualifications for a home?

A: Each Tribe that participates in the program set forth by the ROKiT Homes and UAll partnership will each have their own specific qualifications.

Q: What is the process to get a ROKiT Home?

A: For Tribal citizens that reside on their Tribal reservation or within a Tribal community, contact ROKiT Homes at info@rokithomes.com with any questions about models that you are interested in, add-ons you might be interested in adding, and the location in which the home will be located for a detailed quote.

Q: Are there out-of-pocket costs I should expect? Are there income qualifications?

A: An initial deposit and a small monthly payment are all that's required, and there are no income restrictions to qualify! Specific details can be requested at info@rokithomes.com.

Q: How long will it take until the home is move-in ready?

A: The homes take an estimated 6 weeks to arrive, but once delivered can be assembled the same day! Expect to be able to move in within 6-8 weeks from the day the invoice is paid.

Q: If I live in an urban area, do I need to purchase a property where the home will be located? Or, is there a community where these will be located? If so, where?

A: The ROKiT Homes and UAll project is designed for communities within a Tribal Reservation or Tribal property.
